Notice of Petition by Johns Notice of Petition by Johns Manville for an Adjusted Standard before the Illinois Pollution Control Board Johns Manville, a Delaware corporation, which owns a former manufacturing plant located at 1871 North Persh-ing Dead Watk some Illinois ing Road, Waukegan, Illinois in Lake County has filed a in Lake County has filed a Petition for an Adjusted Standard before the Illinois Pollution Control Board, pursuant to Section 28.1 of the Illinois Environmentai Protection Act, 415 ILCS Section 5/28.1, and 35 III-Adm.Code Sections 104.400 et seq. This petition was filed with the Pollution Con-trol on June 30, 2004, and has been assigned Docket Number AS 04-04 by the Pollution Control Board. Pollution Control Board, Johns Manville formerly operated a manufacturing plant on the property, which ceased operations in 1998. Johns Manville also oper-ated an on-site landfill that received nonhazardous, non asbestos-containing colid wastes comparated solid wastes generated from its own on-site manufrom its own on-site manu-facturing activities while the plant was operating. The proposed adjusted standard would apply to certain specific require-ments contained in the illi-nois Pollution Control Board's land pollution con-trol regulations relating to landfill acs collection and troi regulations relating to landfill gas collection and monitoring and ground-water monitoring. Specifi-cally, JM seeks adjusted standards to 35 III. Adm.Code part 814, which incorporates 35 III. Adm.Code Sections 811.310, 811 311 and 811 319. The ad

811.311 and 811.318. The ad-Justed standard would assist in the efficiency of final closure of the landfill by JM. closure of the landfill by JM. The proposed adjusted standard would address the frequency of landfill gas monitoring, and the location of landfill gas and ground-water monitoring wells. The proposed text of the ad-justed standards is as fol-base. lows:

in lieu of compliance with 35 III.Adm.Code 811.310(c)(1) as applied to the On-Site Landfill at its fa-cility in Waukegan, Illinois, Johns Manville shall oper-ate all gas monitoring de-vices, including the amblent air monitors, such that sam-ples will be collected on a semi-annual basis for a perples will be collected on a semi-annual basis for a per-iod of five years following approval of this adjusted standard. If, at the end of five years, the require-ments for implementing a Landfill Gas Collection Sys-tem (35 III.Adm.Code 811.311) are not met, no fur-ther monitoring will be con-ducted.

In lieu of compliance with 11.311(a)(1) as applied to the On-Site Landfill of its fo-cility in Waukegan, Illinois, Johns Manville shall install a gas management system a gas management system If a methane concentration greater than 50 percent of the lower explosive limit in air, is detected below the ground surface by a moni-toring device or is detected by an ambient air monitor located at 200 feet from the edge of the unit or the prop-erty line, whichever is less. In fleu of compliance with 35 III.Adm.Code 811,318(b)(4) as applied to the On-Site Landfill at its fa-cility in Waukegan, Illinois. the On-Site Landfill at its fa-cility in Waukegan, Illinois, Johns Manville shall instail groundwater monitoring weils at a distance of no more than 200 feet from the edge of the unit or the prop-erty line, which ever is less: Any person may cause a while beering the held in public hearing to be held in the above-described adthe above-described ad-justed standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice.
