REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to November 3, 2004, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On June 30, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On August 4, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner represented that the final decision was received no earlier than July 1, 2004. (Exhibit B)

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.



SECTION 2

1. \$8,424.16 for an adjustment in the total budget. These costs are inconsistent with the associated technical plan. One of the overall goals of the financial review is to assure that costs associated with materials, activities, and services shall be consistent with the associated technical plan (35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.505(c)).

The associated technical plan, dated September 11, 2003 and received by the Illinois EPA on September 15, 2003, was approved in a letter dated November 13, 2003. The approved plan allowed I monitoring well to be placed in the source area. The budget contains costs for 3 monitoring wells.

The following deductions have been made:

Investigation \$4,363.93 (2/3 of proposed Investigation section) Analysis \$250.00 (2 BTEX soil and 2 BTEX groundwater)

Personnel \$1872.50 (2/3 of proposed Delineation Wells & Source Area Well

Installation, and \$800.00 from Off-site Access in Personnel section)

\$719.40 (2/3 of proposed Equipment section) Equipment Field \$750.00 (2/3 of proposed Field Purchases section) \$468.33 (based on deductions in budget)

Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
