#### **Facts**

For this Administrative Citation to **RICHLAND GROUP ENTERPRISES**, **INC**. ("**RICHLAND**") the City of Chicago Department of Environment ("CDOE") states as follows:

- 1. Complainant, CDOE, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2004). CDOE is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.
- 2. Respondent **RICHLAND** engages in waste disposal activities and is a registered Illinois corporation doing business in Illinois.
- 3. On August 4, 2004, CDOE Investigator Lafayette Robertson inspected the site located approximately at 1800 S. Wentworth Avenue. A copy of his inspection report is attached as Exhibit 1 and made a part of this Administrative Citation. Investigator Robertson observed numerous piles of general construction and demolition debris and litter. The general construction and demolition debris and litter was visible by the public and included but was not limited to soil, wood, concrete, and bricks. Investigator Robertson spoke with RICHLAND agent, Wesley Man Wa Ng, who admitted that RICHLAND caused general construction and demolition debris and litter to be deposited at the site.

- 4. Based upon direct observations made by Investigator Robertson during the course of his inspection, CDOE has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:
  - a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2004).
  - b. Respondent caused or allowed deposition of general construction or demolition debris in violation of Section 21(p)(7)(i) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)(i) (2004).
- 5. Investigator Robertson's affidavit, attesting to his material actions and observations, is attached as Exhibit 2 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
- 6. Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2004), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of **Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)**.

### Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- 1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- 2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send a check or money order, payable to the City of Chicago, to:

To ensure that you receive timely and proper credit for your payment, complete a Remittance Form (see Exhibit 3, attached) and include it with your payment.

- 3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance, with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
- 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.

- 7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above and imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) (2004), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
- 8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by CDOE and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.

In Summary: Investigators conducted a routine inspection of the above site address and observed the following:

- History: The above site address is a vacant lot. The site is owned by the Richard land Group, a Real Estate Business located at 3016 S. Halsted St. The owner and manger is Perry Lao, Ph#312-225-2828.
- The site has a fence with a gate. The gate was down and unlocked. Also, the fence to the gate was down along West 19<sup>th</sup> Street. [Open to the public].

Investigators canvass the site and observed new signs of dumping of mixed construction waste debris consisting of the following:

- Brick,

- Concrete,
- Wood,
- Scrap Metal,




