**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On April 21, 2005, the Board adopted its first-notice opinion and order in these consolidated rulemaking dockets, R04-12 and R04-20. The Board proposes to amend its air pollution control rules at 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 211, 214, 218, and 219. The proposed amendments were published in the *Illinois Register* on May 27, 2005, at 29 Ill. Reg. 7418 (Part 211), 7435 (Part 214), 7449 (Part 218), and 7563 (Part 219).
