On October 21, 2004, at the parties' request, the Board extended until January 11, 2005, the time period for Illinois State Toll Highway Authority to appeal a September 1, 2004 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill.
