REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to March 2, 2005, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On October 27, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On November 24, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The earliest the final decision could have been served upon the Petitioner was on October 28, 2004. (Exhibit B)

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.


The Agency has completed the review of the request for reimbursement of corrective action costs from the Illinois Underground Storage Tank Fund for the above-referenced facility. The invoices reviewed covered the period from November 11, 1992 to May 9, 2002. The amount requested was \$81,626.72.

The deductible amount to be assessed on this claim is \$10,000.00, which is being deducted from this payment. In addition to the deductible, there are costs from this request that are not being reimbursed. Listed in Attachment A are the costs which are not being reimbursed from this request and the reasons these costs are not being reimbursed.

()n June 1, 2004, the Agency received your complete request for payment for this claim. As a result of the Agency's review of this claim, a voucher for \$46,804.12 will be prepared for submission to the Comptroller's Office for payment as funds become available based upon the date the Agency received your complete request for payment of this claim. Subsequent claims that have been/are submitted will be processed based upon the date complete subsequent billings requests are received by the Agency.

This constitutes the Agency's final action with regard to the above invoices. An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Hoard (Board) pursuant to Section 22.18b(g) and Section 40 of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the

On behalf of our client, the Estate of Irene Steinheimer ("Steinheimer"), and consistent with Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act") (415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1)), we are requesting that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") join Steinheimer in its request to extend the 35-day period for petitioning for an appeal of the Agency's October 27, 2004, final decision denying a portion of Steinheimer's request for reimbursement from the Leaking Underground Storage Tank ("LUST") Fund. Steinheimer hereby requests an extension for a total of 90 days from December 2, 2004 until March 2, 2005, in order to allow further discussions with the Agency regarding the technical and/or legal rationale for the Agency's denial letter.
