#### JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Respondent, Earl Cazel, is the present owner and/or operator of property located in Manlius Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and designated with Site Code No. 0998175007. Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as the Baugher Property.
- 3. That the Respondent has owned and/or operated said facility since February, 2004.
- 4. That on September 30, 2004, Christy Vargochik, Landfill Inspector, LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

#### VIOLATIONS

5. On the basis of direct observations of Christy Vargochik of the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

That on September 30, 2004, an on-site inspection of said facility disclosed the following:

#### **CIVIL PENALTY**

- 6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00). Additionally, should Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
- 7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.
- 8. When payment is made, your check should be made payable to the LASALLE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT and mailed to:

Also, please complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form, along with your payment, to assure proper documentation of payment.

9. If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

#### GENERAL REMARKS

A solid waste landfill inspection was performed on September 30, 2004, by Christy Vargochik representing the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development under the delegated authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency at the property of Earl Cazel. The property is located on East US Route 6, Section 24, Manlius Township, Seneca, Illinois. During the inspection the following was noted: causing or allowing open dumping; disposing and storing of waste at a site not meeting requirements of the Act and Regulations; causing or allowing the open dumping in a manner which is resulting in litter at the dump site; causing or allowing the open dumping of waste tires, and; failure to submit an application for a permit to develop and operate a landfill.

Weather conditions noted on arrival were sunny and approximately 71 degrees.

I arrived at the site at 2:45 p.m. I could see that a large tree had fallen down over the "driveway". I was able to access the property, because there was enough room to drive around the fallen tree. I paused to photograph the truck filled with debris (photo 958.72). I looked to the southeast, and photographed the large piles of debris (photo 958.73). I resumed the inspection by driving around to the south side of the debris piles. When I reached the last pile, I noticed some new shingles had been dumped in the pile (photo 958.74). I looked to the northeast, and saw some tires in the weeds (photo 958.75). I turned the southeast corner of the pile, and saw at least 6 more tires near the pile (photo 958.76). I continued the inspection by heading in a westerly direction on the north side of the piles. I took a picture of some household waste, blankets, and other items in among the landscape debris (photo 958.77). At this time, I concluded the inspection, and left the site at 2:55 p.m.




