
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.P. Novak):

On February 23, 2005, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Vision Properties Blue Island, LLC (Vision Properties Blue Island) may appeal a January 26, 2005 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency approved the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Phase II Supplemental Investigation as a modification to the existing approved RCRA corrective action program for Vision Properties Blue Island's facility, but with modifications and conditions, regarding Vision Properties Blue Island's solid waste management facility at Blue Island, Cook County.

The Board extends the appeal period until June 1, 2005, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Vision Properties Blue Island fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
