RECOMMENDATION

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On September 16, 2002, the Illinois EPA received a request from For C Pork Farm (log number TC-06-02, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
2. The applicant's address is: For C Pork Farm
2064 E. State Route 9
Paxton, Illinois 60957-4105
3. The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located NW ¼ of Section 35, T24N, R10E of the 3rd P.M. in Iroquois County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste management facilities consisting of one concrete manure pit (16 ft. x 104 ft. x 4 ft. deep) with a manure drain pull plug and the slotted portion of the flooring over the manure pit in one swine finishing building; two concrete manure pits (each 8 ft. x 120 ft. x 4 ft. deep) with a manure drain pull plug and the slotted portion of the flooring over the manure pit in each of the two swine finishing buildings; one glass-lined steel manure storage tank (59 feet in diameter x 19 feet in height) having a concrete floor and footing; one concrete lift tank (10 ft. x 10 ft. x 8 ft. deep); one clay-lined earthen storage basin (300 ft. x 230 ft. x 16.5 ft. deep); approximately 190 feet of 12-inch diameter PVC manure transfer

pipe; and approximately 50 feet of 4-6-inch diameter PVC manure transfer pipe.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock wastes prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2002), defines “pollution control facilities” as:

“any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.”
5. Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5
6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, it is the Illinois EPA’s engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered “pollution control facilities,” pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the

requested tax certification.

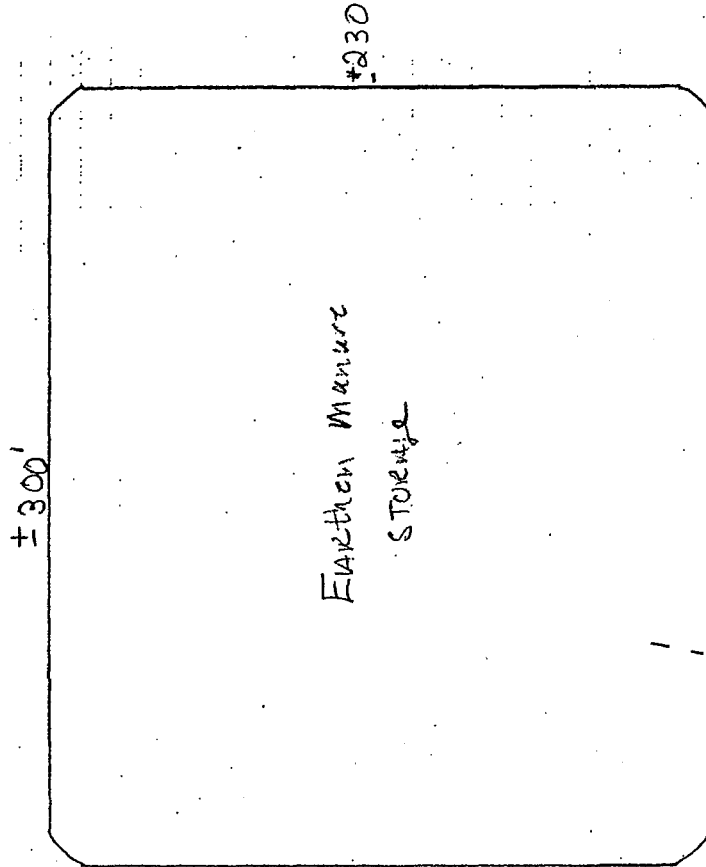

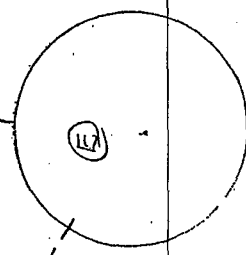

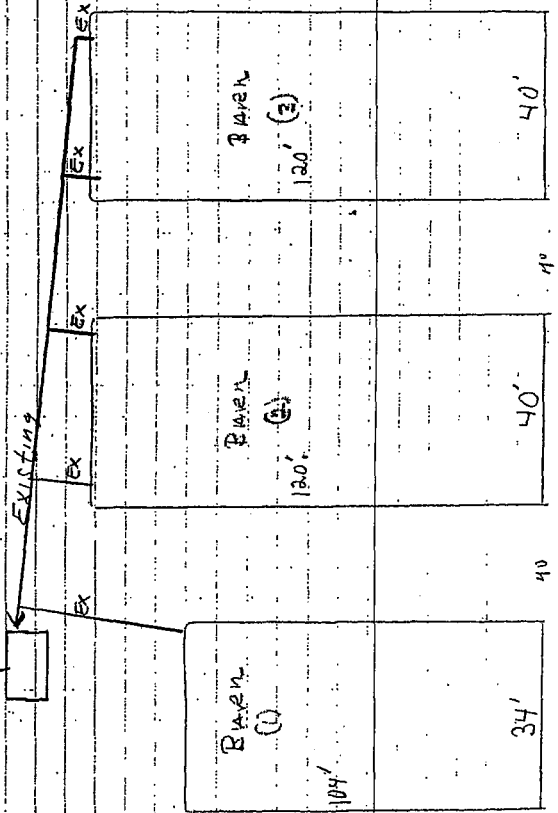
