ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R.C. Flemal):

On November 16, 1994, St. Louis Auto Shredding (SLAS) and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a joint status report pursuant to a October 6, 1994 Board order. The Board directs SLAS and the Agency to file status reports, or a joint status report if the parties prefer, to be received by the Board and hearing officer no later than January 30, 1995, in the event that this matter has not already been resolved and dismissed.
