Facts

For this Administrative Citation to Municipal Trust and Savings Bank Trust No. 1605, the County of Kankakee ("County") states as follows:

1. Complainant, County, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2003). County is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.
2. Respondent, Municipal Trust & Savings Bank Trust #1605, is an Illinois trust, which was the titled owner (at the time of the April 25, 2005 inspection) of real property located at PIN 09-25-100-006, approximately 18.75 acres vacant land E. North St., Bradley, Illinois.
3. On April 25, 2005, County inspector Donna Shehane inspected Respondent's property. A copy of her inspection report is attached as Exhibit 1 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
4. Based upon direct observations made by Ms. Shehane during the course of her inspection, the County has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:

- a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)(2003).
  - b. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, in violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)(2003).
  - c. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general and/or clean construction or demolition debris, in violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)(2003).
5. Ms. Shehane's affidavit, attesting to her material actions and observations, is attached as Exhibit 2 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
  6. Bourbonnais Township Fire Department Report, dated April 25, 2005, is attached as Exhibit 3 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
  7. Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5)(2003), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the three violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00).

**Notices and Instructions to Respondent**

1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.

3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance, with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.


7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above and imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(2003), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).



8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by CDOE and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the County of Kankakee may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event you may also be liable for court costs.

GENERAL REMARKS

Jim Greenstreet and I arrived on site at approximately 3:00 pm to conduct an inspection of this site. The Solid Waste Division had received a complaint that a large amount of material had been piled on the ground near the railroad tracks on this parcel of land. The weather at the time of this inspection was 64 degrees Fahrenheit, with west winds at 10 mph and clear skies.

As we drove south on 4000 E. Road toward the site, we observed black smoke in the air. As we got closer we also observed a firetruck pulling up to the site. We parked the vehicle, identified ourselves to the firemen, and proceeded to the burning site.

Photos # 1-20 were taken of the waste materials on the ground at the site, and the burning of these waste materials.

Photo # 1, taken toward the east, reveals metal, plastic, paper, aluminum cans and other miscellaneous debris on the ground and burning.

Photo # 2 depicts an air conditioner, metal parts, aerosol cans and other miscellaneous debris on the ground and burning.

Photos # 3, # 4, and # 5 show more detail of the types of waste materials present, including lumber, drywall, tires, metal containers, paint cans, etc.

Photo # 6 is a close-up of a metal container on the ground at the site labeled as "nason," an automotive paint product.

Photos # 7 and # 8 were taken of additional waste materials, including cardboard, cans, metal, the remains of a burned tire, a waste tire, and other miscellaneous debris.

Photo # 9 was taken of another pile of waste on the ground at the site, although this pile was not burning. A close-up of this pile can be viewed in photo # 10. The waste in this pile included fabric, plastic, aluminum cans, prescription bottle, glass beer bottle, metal, and other miscellaneous debris.

Photos # 11 and # 12 reveal other waste materials on the ground including a fluorescent light bulb, paint cans, paper cup, and an envelope addressed to Jim Vining.

Photo # 13 was taken of a license plate found in the debris.

Photo # 14 reveals the fire department responding to the fire. Both the Village of Bradley, and the Bourbonnais Township fire departments responded. A copy of the Fire Department Report for this incident is attached to this inspection report.

Photos # 15 and # 16 depict the firemen putting out the fire.

Photo # 17 was taken of another envelope contained in a waste pile, addressed to Jim Vining.

Photo # 18 was taken of the firemen sifting through the smoldering fire.

Photos # 19 and # 20 depict automobile parts, an air conditioner, a bicycle, and other debris in the fire.

We left the site at approximately 3:40 pm, leaving the firemen to finish their work.

The Municipal Trust and Savings Bank, Trust # 1605, was found to be out of compliance at the time of this inspection.

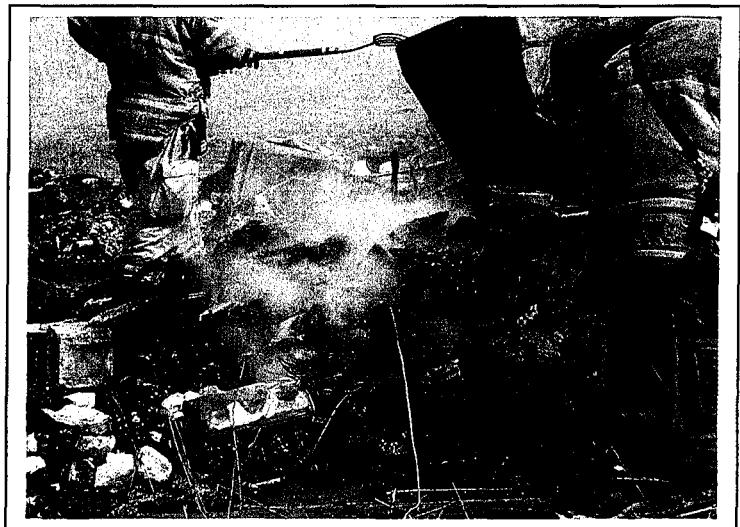
