

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 9, 1995, the Marathon Oil Co. (Marathon) filed a petition for a site-specific rulemaking. Marathon is seeking relief for its Robinson, Crawford County, facility from the application of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 216.381 which establishes a 200 ppm limit for carbon monoxide. The petition meets the informational requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.121 and 102.141 and shall therefore proceed to hearing. Additionally, the petition was accompanied by a request for waiver of the 200-person signature requirement which the Board hereby grants.
