
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On October 4, 1994, Resourceful Environmental Ideas, Inc. (REI) filed a petition for review seeking the reversal of an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) solid waste determination which classified "shredded polyethylene plastic" as a solid waste, rather than a recyclable material, or "fuel." On October 31, 1994, the Agency filed a motion to dismiss the petition for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Thereafter on November 9, 1994, REI filed a motion to withdraw the petition.

The motion to withdraw is granted and the docket in this matter is hereby closed.
