ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Dr. Satchell):


On February 11, 1980 Illinois Power Company (IPC) filed a motion for stay of certain conditions of NPDES Permit No. IL0001554. On February 19, 1980 the Environmental Protection Agency filed a response and on February 26, 1980 IPC filed a reply. The permit conditions with only two exceptions are new or discretionary. The conditions which set concentration limits for total suspended solids in Attachments B2 and B3 are old permit conditions mandated by Rule 408(a) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution. Stay of these conditions is denied. The following conditions are stayed for 120 days from the date of this Order:

1. Attachment B1, Table and Paragraph 5 Limitation on Total Chlorine Residual.
2. Attachment B1, Paragraph 7.
3. Attachment B1A, Paragraphs 3, 4.
4. Attachment B1B, Paragraph 1.
5. Attachment B2, Paragraph 4.
6. Attachment B3, Paragraph 4.
7. Attachment B4, Oil and Grease Sampling.
8. Attachment H, Standard Conditions 3, 7, 9, 22, 27, 28, 29.
