ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C. A. Manning):

On November 21, 1994, complainant filed a motion to reconsider the Board's November 3, 1994 order dismissing this proceeding. For the reason discussed below the Board will deny the motion to reconsider.

The Board finds that the complainant has not pointed to an error in the decision or facts in the record which were overlooked. Therefore, the Board denies the motion to reconsider and affirms the November 3, 1994 order.
