ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.C. Marlin):


On June 26, 1992 the Agency filed a motion to extend the time in which to file its recommendation. Amoco filed its variance petition with the Board on May 26, 1992, and the recommendation was due June 26, 1992. The Agency states that Amoco notified the Agency on June 17, 1992 of its intent to file an amended variance petition by August 1, 1992.

The Agency accordingly alternatively requests an extension of time in which it may file its recommendation to 30 days after the date Amoco files its amended variance petition or by August 14, 1992 if Amoco fails to file an amended variance petition by August 1, 1992. The Agency states that Amoco does not object to the granting of this extension.

The motion for extension is granted as requested.
