ORDER OF THE BOARD (J. Theodore Meyer):


This matter is before the Board on the parties' December 13, 1995 Agreed Motion to Request Extension of Time to Set Hearing Date. The complaint was filed on June 20, 1995 and respondent, Polymer Color, Inc. was required to file its answer by July 21, 1995. Due to ongoing negotiations, the parties have twice requested an extension of time for the respondent to file its answer, and to set a hearing date.

The parties report that negotiations have resulted in a draft settlement which is being circulated among the parties for signatures. Therefore, the parties request additional time to obtain these signatures.

The Board grants the parties' request to extend the original 90-day hearing time frame requirement to January 30, 1996. The hearing officer assigned to this matter shall order a status report for January 15, 1996 in which the parties shall indicate an anticipated date of resolution in this matter.
