ORDER OF THE BOARD: (C. A. Manning)

On January 31, 1994, the respondent, Mr. Robert Waldron sent a letter to the Board requesting that the Board remove the administrative citation issued by the complainant, County of Jackson. The Board will construe this letter as a motion for dismissal. The Board entered a default order against the respondent on November 18, 1993, finding violation and imposing a \$1,500.00 penalty.
