ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. McFawn):

This matter is before the Board on a May 17, 1995 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Agency Recommendation. The Agency claims that it needs more time to thoroughly review and analyze information, citing additional material regarding flexographic printing in Illinois which may significantly impact the petitioner.

Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.180(a), after the Agency investigates a variance petition, it is required to make its recommendation to the Board on the disposition of the petition within 30 days after the filing of the petition. DRG Medical Packaging, Inc., (DRG) filed the Petition for Variance on March 14, 1995. The Agency recommendation was therefore due on April 29, 1995. On April 12, 1995 the Agency filed a Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Agency Recommendation and by Board order of April 20, 1995, the Board granted the extension until May 15, 1995. The Agency has requested an additional extension until July 17, 1995. Considering the statutory decision deadline of October 30, 1995, the Board hereby grants the Agency an extension of time to file the recommendation until July 17, 1995.
