
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

This matter comes before the Board on a "Joint Stipulation and Motion for Entry of Order" filed by the parties on April 7, 1993. The parties jointly ask that the Board enter an order directing the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) to reimburse the petitioner for underground storage tank removal costs in the amount of \$6,500.00.

The Board makes no findings of facts or conclusions of law in this matter. The Board hereby grants the parties' request. The Agency is directed to reimburse petitioner for underground storage tank removal costs in the amount of \$6,500.00. This docket is closed.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
