ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

Section 9.1(e) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) requires the Board to adopt exemptions from the definition of volatile organic material (VOM) which are "identical in substance" with USEPA exemptions [originally, adopted pursuant to its "Recommended Policy on the Control of Volatile Organic Compounds", and now codified as 40 CFR 51.100(s)]. Accordingly, the Board reserved this docket for USEPA amendments during the period from July 1 through December 31, 1992.

USEPA did not amend its codified policy, the 40 CFR 51.100(s) definition of "volatile organic compound", during this update period.

For the foregoing reason, the Board hereby dismisses this proceeding.
