WMI states that it finds it not economically reasonable to go to hearing in this matter and that while not admitting the violation, it will make payment of the \$500.00 as specified in the Citation within 30 days of the date of this Order.


Therefore, pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1), the Board finds that WMI has violated the provision alleged in the Administrative Citation. Since there is one (1) such violation, the total penalty to be imposed is set at \$500.00.
