Proposed Rule. Dismissal Order.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (By J. Anderson):

Pursuant to Sections 7.2, and 22.4(d) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act), the Board would normally propose amendments to the Underground Storage Tank (UST) regulations semi-annually. Accordingly, the Board reserved this docket for USEPA amendments during the period from July 1 through December 31, 1991.

The following USEPA actions appeared in the Federal Register during the period July 1 through December 31, 1991:



In R91-14, pursuant to P.A. 87-323, and other amendments, the Board repealed most of its UST rules. The above USEPA actions affect sections which are no longer reflected in the Board's rules. There is therefore no need to amend the Board rules.
