HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 6, 2005, the parties participated in a telephone status conference with the hearing officer. Respondent's attorney is still waiting for respondent to authorize a noise expert. The parties are directed to participate in a telephone status conference with the hearing officer at 2:00 p.m. on August 9, 2005. The status conference shall be initiated by the complainants, although each party is responsible for their own appearance.
