# REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to October 14, 2005, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On June 10, 2005, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On July 7, 2005, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner did not indicate when the final decision was received. The earliest date the document could have been received was June 11, 2005. (Exhibit B)

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the High Priority Corrective Action Completion Report (report) for the above-referenced incident. The report was dated February 17, 2004 and was received by the Illinois EPA on February 18, 2005. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

Pursuant to 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act and 35 III. Adm. Code 732.409(c) and 732.503(b), the report is rejected for the following reason:

The MSDS for Koch Petroleum's "100 Low Lead Aviation Gasoline" has been reviewed by Illinois EPA's Toxicity Assessment Unit. For both grades avgas still in use for piston engine aircraft, 100/115 and 115/145, the proper indicator contaminants are:

- BETX (note that Toluene will be present at much greater levels in avgas)
- n-Hexane
- Lead
- 1,2-Dibromoethane (Ethylene dibromide)

At this time the four groundwater monitoring wells should be sampled and analyzed for each of the above-referenced indicator contaminants, and five soil borings should be advanced as follows: One soil sample should be collected from the approximate location and depth of the following soil samples:

4007-06A Floor North Floor South West Wall Center; and South Wall

Each of these five soil samples should be analyzed for the above-referenced indicator; contaminants. Regarding lead analysis, both total and either TCLP or SPLP analysis should be conducted. In addition, these soil samples do not need to be reanalyzed for any constituents for which they have already been analyzed (such as BTEX).

If there are no exceedences in the soil and groundwater samples of Tier 1 remediation objectives. then a No Further Remediation Letter can be issued at that time.

Work associated with this resampling effort will be eligible for reimbursement from the UST Fund. If reimbursement from the UST fund will be sought, a budget for this work must be submitted prior to the eventual issuance of a No Further Remediation Letter.

Please note that an Owner Property Summary form will also need to be completed and submitted to Illinois EPA prior to issuance of the No Further Remediation Letter. This form may be found at the following internet address:

#### Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the dwner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
