Order of the Board (by J. Dumelle):



On March 12, 1990, Abbott Laboratories ("Abbott") filed a motion for leave to file a single copy of Group Exhibits 1 and 2. Group Exhibit 1 consists of the transcripts from hearings conducted in R86-10, the rulemaking in which the Board adopted Reasonably Available Control Technology ("RACT") rules for pharmaceutical manufacturers. Group Exhibit 2 consists of the public and confidential exhibits from R86-10.

Abbott states that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and the Department of Energy and Natural Resources (DENR) have no objection to this motion. No other objections to this motion have been filed.
