ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Nardulli):

In response to an October 7, 1988 Motion for Protection of Confidential Business Information filed by the Petitioner, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.107(c)(3), the information on page 3 of Tab 2 in the Petitioner's Post-Hearing Brief is hereby classified as material "Not Subject to Disclosure". This material is exempted from the requirement that the Board's files be open to all reasonable public inspection by 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 101.107(b)(5). This provision allows the Board to classify income and earning data, when not an issue in the proceeding, as not subject to disclosure and therefore not part of the public record.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby ordered to treat this material as "Not Subject to Disclosure". Further, persons receiving service of this matter are ordered to keep the information that is not subject to disclosure out of the public record and to maintain the confidentiality of the information.
