ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On April 15, 1996 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and Richard Johnson (Johnson) filed a notice of extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act, relating to a March 11, 1996 Agency final determination.

By order of April 18, 1996 the Board reserved docket PCB 96-216 for any petition which might be filed by Johnson. The order stated, "In the event that Johnson fails to file an appeal on or before June 9, 1996 (the 90th day after March 11, 1996), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

No petition has been filed. This matter is dismissed and the docket is closed as unnecessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

Section 41 of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/41 (1994)) provides for the appeal of final Board orders within 35 days of the date of service of this order.
