ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):


On April 23, 1999, the Illinois Attorney General and J.L. Clark, Inc., a Delaware corporation, filed an amended complaint, an amended stipulation and proposal for settlement, an agreed motion for leave to file *instanter*, and a motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement pursuant to Section 31(c)(2) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(2) (1996)). The Board considers the parties' filing of the motion for leave to file *instanter* as a request to reopen this docket. The Board grants the motion for leave to file *instanter* the amended complaint and amended stipulation.

In accordance with the requirements set forth in Section 31 (c)(2) of the Act, the Board directs the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice for the amended stipulation and proposal for settlement and request for relief from hearing concerning the amended complaint filed by the Illinois Attorney General on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Any person may file a written demand for hearing within 21 days after receiving the notice. If a hearing is requested, the Board will accordingly deny the parties' request for relief and schedule a hearing.
