
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon a December 29, 1983 petition for variance from old Rule 205(n)(1)(G) of Chapter 2: Air Pollution (now 35 Ill. Adm. Code 215.204) filed on behalf of All-Steel, Inc. (All-Steel). That petition is deficient under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121 in that it fails to include an environmental impact assessment. The Board notes that the proceedings in PCB 82-110 (All-Steel's previous variance) should probably be incorporated by reference, and that despite the fact that hearing has been neither waived nor requested, hearing will be required.

Unless All-Steel files an amended petition curing the above-noted defect within 45 days of the date of this Order, the petition will be subject to dismissal pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.125.
