ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

On January 6, 1984, Dunn Company filed a motion to dismiss this enforcement case based upon the misnomer of the respondent and a lack of specificity in the complaint. Misnomer of a party is not grounds for dismissal [35 Ill. Adm. Code 103.121(a)]. Further, while these complaints could certainly be more specific, reasonable latitude is given to citizens who prosecute their own cases and greater specificity can be gained through discovery. The motion is, therefore, denied.
