PROPOSED RULE SECOND NOTICE

PROPOSED ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon a January 27, 1982, petition to adopt regulations concerning radiation hazards filed on behalf of the Department of Nuclear Safety (DNS) by the Attorney General's Office. The Board adopted a Proposed Rule/First Notice Order on February 6, 1986, which was published at 10 Illinois Register 3849 on February 21, 1986. The Board received no comments during the first notice period.

In its Proposed Rule/ First Notice Order, the Board proposed the correction of the following typographical errors: 1) in section 1000.201: Definitions, the word "Therman" which appeared in the table within the definition of "Rem" was changed to "Thermal"; and 2) anywhere in the rules where "pCi/l" appeared, "uCi/l" was substituted in its place. The Board was informed by the Secretary of States' Office that in order to make these changes, the Board must proceed through first and second notice before final adoption prior to filing these corrections. The Board opened a new docket (R82-2B) to make these changes and incorporated the entire record of the R82-2 proceeding. The Board believes that it has fully complied with the regulatory requirements under the Environmental Protection Act and that no additional hearings or an Economic Impact Study are required since these amendments are technical corrections.

Having received no comments during the first notice period, the Board hereby proposes for second notice the amendments made to 35 Ill. Adm. Code, Part 1000 as they appeared at first notice, without change.
