RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

On May 30, 1984 the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (49 Fed. Reg. 22598) of the adoption of the following amendment to the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS):

Subpart GGG - Standards of Performance for Equipment Leaks of VOC in Petroleum Refineries - 40 CFR Part 60, (35 Ill. Adm. Code 230.690).

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal new source performance standard amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendments as peremptory rules.

ORDER

The Board hereby adopts the following amendments to Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Subchapter e: Peremptory Rules; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards.

Section 230.690 Equipment Leaks of VOC in Petroleum Refineries

The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 60, Subpart GGG as adopted at 49 Fed. Reg. 22598, May 30 1984.
