

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On March 21, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until June 14, 2002, the time period within which Chroma Corporation (Chroma) may appeal a February 11, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency issued a final decision that certain of Chroma's "stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity are possibly causing or contributing to a violation of water quality standard . . . and may not be appropriately covered by the NPDES General Storm Water Permit for Industrial Activities . . . [making it] necessary that Chroma . . . apply for an NPDES individual permit." Chroma's facility is located in McHenry County. Because Chroma failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
