

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On January 23, 1987, Duo Fast Corporation ("Duo Fast") filed a request for extension of time to complete its statement of justification in the above-captioned matter. By Interim Order, dated January 8, 1987, the Board triggered the justification and determination process for Duo Fast's confidential and trade secret claims in R82-14. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 120.220, the owner of a trade secret has "ten working days" from receipt of a request for justification which can be extended on timely request of the owner. Duo Fast presents such a timely request and, in addition, states compelling reasons necessitating additional time. Duo Fast's request for additional time, until February 6, 1987, is granted.
