ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):


This matter comes before the Board upon Respondents' May 30, 1985 motion for change of venue and amended motion of June 7. The Agency and the Hearing Officer made responsive filings to the initial motion on June 3. As hearing is scheduled for July 17-19, and discovery is still proceeding, the Board will decide the motion in advance of response to the amended motion.

Without ruling on the substance of the motions' contentions, the Board will reassign this action to a new hearing officer to avoid any risk of clouding the record, Complainant's case, or Respondents' case in this matter. The Clerk is directed to advise the parties of the new assignment on or before June 17, 1985. In light of this direction, Respondents' connected June 7 motion for stay and June 7 and 10 motions for stenographic recording of pre-trial proceedings are denied as unnecessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
