RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

This matter comes before the Board upon a June 24, 1985 notice (50 Fed. Reg. 26122) published by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) of the promulgation of an addition to the National Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources (NSPS):

Subpart KKK: Equipment Leaks of VOC from
Onshore Natural Gas Processing Plants
40 CFR 60 (35 Ill. Adm. Code 230.710)

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Environmental Protection Act, the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal NSPS amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendment as a peremptory amendment.

ORDER


The Board hereby adopts the following amendment to Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution: Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards:

SUBPART KKK: EQUIPMENT LEAKS OF VOC FROM
ONSHORE NATURAL GAS PROCESSING PLANTS

The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 60, Subpart KKK, as adopted at 50 Fed. Reg. 26122, June 24, 1985.
