On May 2, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until July 21, 2002, the time period within which Shearon, Inc. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency rejected the high priority corrective action plan budget regarding a leaking underground storage tank at 101 Ratzlaff Street, Harvard, McHenry County. Because Shearon failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
