
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by W. J. Nega):

This matter comes before the Board upon a Motion for Reconsideration filed by the Petitioner on September 4, 1984. The Petitioner requests that the Board delete the cyanide condition initially set by the Agency and accepted by the Board in granting the provisional variance on August 22, 1984.

That motion is denied. Pursuant to Ill. Rev. Stat. 1983, ch. 111½, par. 1037(b), the Agency recommends to the Board what provisional variance conditions to accept. If the Petitioner does not agree with a condition, it should inform the Agency.
