ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On July 20, 1984, a formal complaint was filed with the Board by Russell and Hazel Treat. The Respondent was not served with a copy of the complaint or notified in any manner of the pending matter. The Board notified the Treats by both mail and telephone regarding this deficiency. During these communications, it became apparent that the Treats desired an informal, rather than a formal, complaint proceeding before the Board. On August 20, 1984, the Treats filed an informal complaint.

The formal complaint docketed as PCB 84-94 is dismissed without prejudice. The Treats shall not be precluded by this Order from pursuing a formal complaint in the future if they desire.
