
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On April 5, 1984, the City of Wyoming ("Wyoming") filed a Petition for Variance. This matter will be set for hearing. To allow the Board to make a more informed decision in this matter, the parties are requested to provide any available information, at the hearing, at least on the following:

1. The nature, location, frequency and duration of existing basement back-ups and what impact could be expected from the new first ward connections.
2. Existing flows and capacities of the sewer system and sewage treatment plant.
3. Whether the record and opinion in PCB 77-252 is to be incorporated in this proceeding.
4. The proposed method to achieve full ultimate compliance with applicable regulations including a schedule of time for the implementation of all phases of the control program.
5. The measures to be undertaken during the period of the variance to minimize the environmental impact of the additional flows.
