ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

On April 20, 1984 Engineered Coated Products, Inc. (ECP) filed a Petition requesting an extension of the variance granted in PCB 82-2. Although it is a request for a nine month extension of time to comply with 35 Ill. Adm. Code 215.204 and 215.211 [formerly Rules 205(n) and 205(j), respectively], Petitioner is required to comply with the procedural rules for filing a Petition for Variance found at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.120 and 104.121. This requirement is set out at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.123: Extension of Variance. That Section also provides that Petitioner may request the incorporation of the prior record, in this case PCB 82-2, rather than resubmit information. Petitioner is directed to comply with the above named Sections. If in so doing, Petitioner requests incorporation of the record in PCB 82-2, Petitioner is cautioned to detail any changes in that information, especially changes and reasons for the same in its compliance plan. Petitioner is also directed to request or waive hearing. If waived, Petitioner is reminded to submit by affidavit verifying the validity of any new facts, and verifying that the information resubmitted has not changed.

Petitioner has thirty days to correct the pleading as directed, or the Petition will be subject to dismissal as incomplete.
