
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

The City of Tuscola filed its petition for this proceeding on October 31, 1983. The stay granted by the Board on April 5, 1984, expired on August 6, 1984. The Board had been aware of continuing negotiations between the City of Tuscola and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to develop a feasible plan both for a related variance case (PCB 84-146) and for this regulatory proceeding. However, the record in this matter is silent as to what has happened in the last six months.

Unless the City of Tuscola files with the Clerk of the Board within twenty-one days a letter of intent to proceed promptly in this matter, this proceeding will be subject to dismissal.
