

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On March 7, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until June 14, 2002, the time period within which Marlena Mackie (Mackie) may appeal a January 31, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of Mackie's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank at Pete's Marathon, 539 South Poplar, Centralia, Marion County. Because Mackie failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
