RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On April 16, 1982 the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice of the adoption of the two following amendments to the New Source Performance Standards (47 Fed. Reg. 16564-16579 and 16582-16590, respectively):

Lead-Acid Battery Manufacturing Plants, 40
C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart KK; 47 Fed. Reg.
16564-16579 (April 16, 1982); Rule 935; and

Phosphate Rock Plants, 40 C.F.R. Part 60,
Subpart NN; 47 Fed. Reg. 16582-16590
(April 16, 1982); Rule 938.

Rules 935 and 938 of Chapter 2: Air Pollution are presently reserved. Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the above-noted amendments to Part IX of Chapter 2.
