ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

This petition for variance, filed May 20, 1985, is deficient in certain respects, failing to contain much of the information specified in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121 - 104.124. It does not specify the length of time for which variance is requested, or when Mr. Royer or Mr. Hemp would be eligible to take the Class 2 examination. The financial or other hardship which would be imposed in retaining Mr. Hess on a contractual basis is not specifically detailed. The petition does not contain an assessment of the environmental impact of grant of variance -- for example what is the current quality of the effluent discharged into the (unidentified) receiving stream? Finally, the petition fails to either request hearing, or instead to contain a waiver of hearing along with an affidavit attesting to the truth of the facts contained in the petition.

If an amended petition curing these defects is not filed within 45 days of the date of this Order, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
