ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):


This matter comes before the Board upon an August 31, 1984 motion entitled "request for extension of variance." However, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.123 this filing is a petition for variance extension and is hereby docketed as new case PCB 84-146, thereby dismissing docket PCB 83-77.

The petition is deficient because it (1) fails to request incorporation of the records Opinion and Order in PCB 83-77 and (2) fails to request a hearing or in the alternative, fails to waive hearing and submit the required affidavit.

Unless the City of Tuscola files an amended petition curing the above-noted defects within 45 days of the date of this Order, the petition will be subject to dismissal.
