ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R. C. Flemal):

This matter comes before the Board on its own motion for correction of the Opinion and Order dated October 1, 1987.

The Board notes that the Order incorrectly granted the variance from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.106 and 304.124(a) as it applies to total dissolved solids, iron, and manganese. The Board intended to grant the variance as it applies to total suspended solids, iron, and manganese.


The first paragraph of the Order of October 1, 1987 is hereby corrected to read as follows:

Petitioner, the City of Rock Island, is hereby granted variance from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.106 and from 304.124(a) (as it applies to total suspended solids, iron, and manganese) for discharges from Petitioner's potable water treatment works to Black Hawk Creek, subject to the following conditions:
