RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):


On May 25, 1983, the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (48 Fed. Reg. 23608) of the adoption of the following amendments to the New Source Performance Standards:

1. General Provisions - 40 C.F.R. 60.13 (Rule 901);
2. Nitric Acid Plants - 40 C.F.R. 60.73 (Rule 905);
3. Sulfuric Acid Plants - 40 C.F.R. 60.84 (Rule 906);
4. Petroleum Refineries - 40 C.F.R. 60.105 (Rule 908);
5. Primary Copper Smelters - 40 C.F.R. 60.165 (Rule 914);
6. Primary Zinc Smelters - 40 C.F.R. 60.175 (Rule 915);
7. Primary Lead Smelters - 40 C.F.R. 60.185 (Rule 916) and
8. Appendix B - Performance Specifications, 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Appendix B (Rule 952).

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the above-noted amendments as amendments to Rules 901, 905, 906, 908, 914, 915, 916 and 952 of Part IX of Chapter 2: Air Pollution.
