CHAPTER 2: RULE 204

SULFUR DIOXIDE EMISSION LIMITATIONS,

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On May 24, 1983 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a Motion to Correct Rule 204 as adopted on February 24, 1983 and filed with the Secretary of State on March 28, 1983. CPC International, Inc. (CPC) filed a Response on June 17, 1983. The Agency requests that Rules 204(f) and (g) be amended to indicate that the exemption procedure provided in subparagraph (g) be applicable only to combustion emission sources burning solid fuel exclusively. It is not possible under the Administrative Procedure Act (<u>Ill. Rev. Stat.</u> 1981, ch. 127, pars. 1001 <u>et seq</u>.) to amend the rules now filed without formal rulemaking. Therefore, the Agency may propose these revisions in a new rulemaking.
